

VR Headset Application

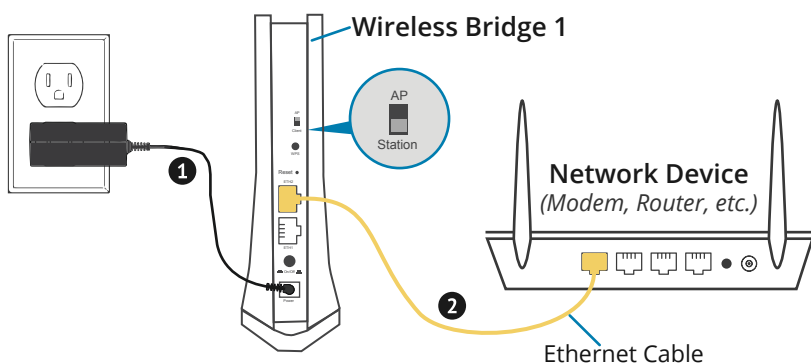
If your Gaming PC does not have a direct Ethernet Cable connection to your router, no worries! The WB-1750-KIT uses private point-to-point LAN that penetrates through walls and other building materials to deliver an Ethernet Connection to your Gaming PC and Powerful Wireless to your VR Headset.

SETTING UP YOUR WB-1750-KIT for VR

A Setup Wireless Bridge 1

Note: Ensure Wireless Bridge 2 is set to Station mode by sliding the AP/Station Switch to the downward position.

- 1 Plug in the **Power Adapter** into the device labeled **Wireless Bridge 1** and press the **Power Button** to the ON position (IN).

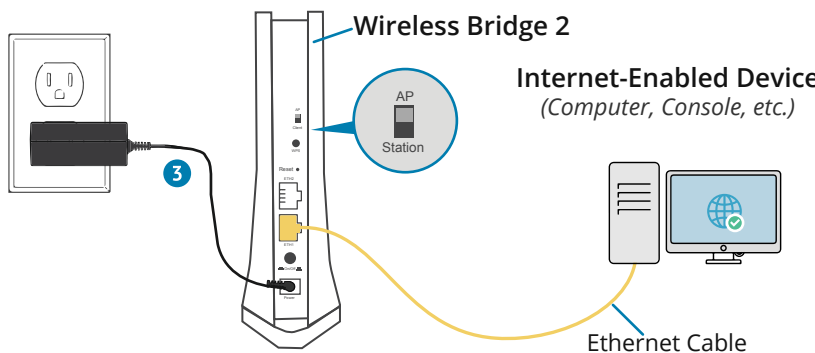


- 2 Connect **Wireless Bridge 1** to your **Network Device** (Gateway, Router, etc.) with an **Ethernet (RJ-45) cable**. You can use either Ethernet ports of the Wireless Bridge to make this connection.

B Setup Wireless Bridge 2

Note: Ensure Wireless Bridge 2 is set to AP mode by sliding the AP/Station Switch to the upward position.

- 3 Setup **Wireless Bridge 2** closest to the location of the **Internet Enabled Device**. Plug in the power adapter and press the **Power Button** to the ON position (IN).



- 4 Connect **Wireless Bridge 2** to an **Internet Enabled Device** (Computer, Console, etc.) with an **Ethernet (RJ-45) cable**. You can use either Ethernet ports of the Wireless Bridge to make this connection.

C Setup via WPS (WiFi Protected Setup)

- 5 Press and release the **WPS button** on **Wireless Bridge 1** and the **WPS LED** will start to blink **GREEN**.
- 6 Within two minutes press and release the **WPS button** on **Wireless Bridge 2** and the **WPS LED** will start to blink **GREEN**.



- 7 Upon successful connection, the **WPS LED** and **WiFi LED** will light up solid **GREEN** on both of the Wireless Bridges.
- 8 Repeat steps 3-7 to add additional station devices.

Please refer to Section E for troubleshooting if the devices are not working properly.

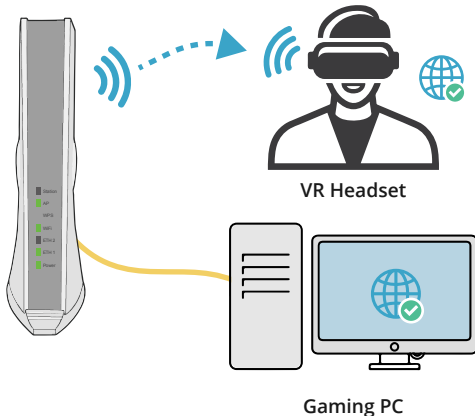
D Connecting Your VR Headset

- 9 Find the network name (SSID) and Password (WiFi Key) at the bottom of the WB-1750 #2.

Example:
SSID : NexusLinkE221 **WiFi Key : 265940E221**

- 10 On your wireless device (VR Headset, etc.), select the WB-1750's network name from your wireless device's standard list and enter the WiFi Key.

- 11 You're all done! You have successfully connected your Wireless Device to the WB-1750 Wireless Bridge.
